- Outgrowth of the Northeast Florida Long Term Recovery Organization for Irma

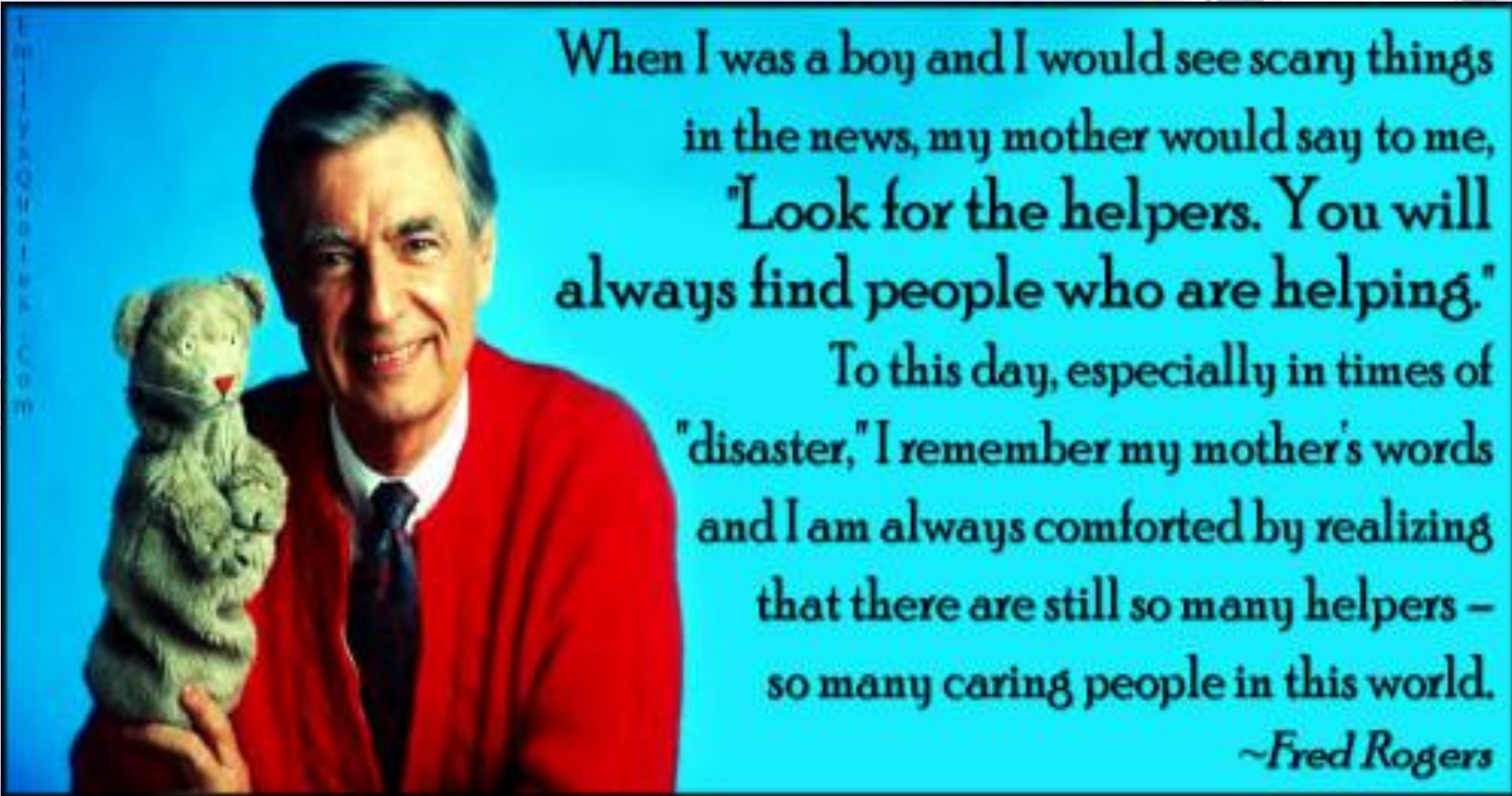
